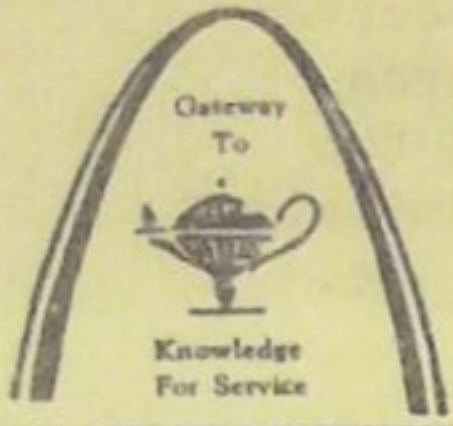

CARL GOODSON APPOINTED ACADEMIC DEAN FOR ST. LOUIS CAMPUS

Carl Goodson, Arkadelphia, Arkansas, has accepted the position of Academic Dean for Missouri Baptist College, Saint Louis Campus, it was announced by Dr. L.A. Foster, president. Dr. Goodson, now professor of religion at Ouachita University in Arkadelphia, will assume his new work June 1, 1968, at the close of the current school year.

He has taught in his present position since 1961. Previously, he was on the faculty of Southwest Baptist College, Bolivar, Missouri, as professor of Bible and Greek, a position he filled for fifteen years.

Dr. Goodson is a graduate of Southwest Baptist College and of William Jewell College, Liberty, Missouri. His theological training was taken at Southern Baptist Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky, and Central Baptist Seminary, Kansas City, Kansas. He received the Master of Theology degree from Southern Seminary and the Doctor of Theology degree from Central Seminary.

As academic dean for the Saint Louis Campus, Dr. Goodson's primary function will be establishing faculty and curriculum on the local campus. In this capacity, he will work with President Foster and Virgil L. Vaughn, Administrative Vice-president for the Saint Louis Campus.

Dr. Goodson, a native of St. Louis, is a member of the American Association of University Professors, the National Collegiate Honors Council, the American Academy of Religion, the Society of Biblical Literature, the Southern Baptist Historical Society, and is currently listed in Who's Who in American Education. He serves as secretary of the Arkadelphia Civitan Club and is chairman of a Boy Scout troop.

He is married to the former Rozelle W. Palmer. Dr. and Mrs. Goodson, with their five children, plan to move to St. Louis in June.

FIRST OF ST. LOUIS CAMPUS STUDENT CONFERENCES SET FOR MID-MARCH

High school students, their parents, school counselors and pastors will be told about plans for the new St. Louis Campus of Missouri Baptist College at "College Day Conferences" on Saturday, March 16 and March 23. The meeting on March 16 is to be at the First Baptist Church, St. Johns. The second meeting (March 23) will be at the Kirkwood Baptist Church, Kirkwood.

Beginning at 9:30 a.m., the conference sessions will be concluded at a noon luncheon, with the students and their friends as guests of the college. A tour of the new campus and buildings under construction will be conducted after lunch.

Darrell R. Atkins, director of admissions, is in charge of the College Day programs. Faculty members will assist in the conference and will lead counseling sessions about college careers in varied fields.
