PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

At the recent meeting of the Executive Board of the Missouri Baptist Convention I was pleased to give the report on Christian Education to the Board. One of the things that I told them was that Missouri Baptist College had a covenant with Missouri Baptists. For our part of the covenant we promised to:

1. Hold up as the highest wisdom the truth of Jesus Christ
2. Provide quality, person-centered education
3. Train young adults

for the ministry

4. Be sensitive to the support of the churches
5. Employ full time faculty and staff who are committed Christians.

For their part of the covenant I asked them to:

1. Continue to support the College through Cooperative Program gifts.
2. Encourage students to attend Missouri Baptist College
3. Visit the campus
4. Remember the faculty, staff, and students in their daily prayers.

When I was the Vice President of a college, I often said it was my role to "put into practice the public proclamations of the President." I will always try to be accurate in my public proclamations, and I hope these covenant terms are agreeable to all of us as we go about the Lord's work here at MBC.

DORMITORY UPDATE

Some of you may be wondering what is going on with the new women's dormitory. Over the past several weeks I have been involved in meetings with our architects, engineers, and attorneys as well as the mayor and city manager of Creve Coeur. We have not yet been able to reach an agreement whereby the City would approve our site plan and allow construction to begin. I feel that the College has done everything possible to be a good citizen and resolve the conflict in a Christian manner. However, we still have differences. A settlement has been proposed by the City and is under consideration though it is not satisfactory in its present form. There are many issues to consider- cost of litigation, construction delays, effect on recruiting, keeping faith with donors, technical problems with moving the building, and of course, politics. pray that a worthy solution can be found.
